Each year, over two million wildebeest, zebra and other herbivores trek from the southern Serengeti to the lush green grasses of the Masai Mara. As the herds of wildebeest, zebras and gazelles with a fascinating quest for survival in which only the strong survive and the weak are left behind as prey for their lethal predators, blindly jump from riverbank ledges and into the Mara River lurking with over 2000 crocodiles. When the food supply dwindles in the Masai Mara plains and the rains move on, so do the herds.

Day1: Tel Aviv - Nairobi – Lake Naivasha

"Hello! Welcome to Kenya", "Jambo ! Karibu Kenya", The land of Safari and great wildlife, cultures from different tribes, tastes and aromas.


Arriving early afternoon with an overnight flight from Israel via an intermediate destination to Nairobi (Kenya capital city) at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport named after Jomo Kenyatta – founder and father of the Kenyan nation.

Upon landing, meet and assist at the airport will be done by a Feel Holiday driver guide who will also be with you throughout the trip, from arriving and departing Kenya.

From the airport proceed to Lake Naivasha Reserve. The lake is considered one of the highest fresh lakes in the Great Rift Valley. The lake spreads over 130 km² and is surrounded by dense vegetation. Lake Naivasha is home to many animals : Hippos are a common sight at Lake with both lesser and greater species of flamingos a colorful sight, especially during the wetter months .Other wildlife like; giraffes , warthog ,antelopes and various Columbus monkeys hanging from the trees. Arrive at the Lodge at sun set check-in and have dinner.

Overnight at Naivasha Lodge on Half board

Day 2 :Lake Naivasha - Maasai Mara ("Following the World's Largest Migration")



Morning boat ride at lake Naivasha, viewing the beautiful scenery of the open waters and its surroundings ,excellent way to see numerous birdlife and hippos up close. The lake has a peninsula located at the heart known as "Cresent Island" where animals roam undisturbed, including giraffes, zebras and deer. (*Note :Visiting the island is optional at own cost*).

After breakfast then depart to Maasai Mara Reserve. It is one of the highlights of safari trips to Kenya and without a doubt Mara is one of the most beautiful and fascinating nature reserves in the world. We will enter the reserve and arrive at the lodge for a check – lunch, getting organized and going on our first tour of the reserve. As we noted in the introduction - the park is an accurate picture of Africa as depicted in Hollywood movies - herds of zebras and beasts of prey follow them to flock north in packs, herds of buffalo crossing the Mara River wildly among crocodiles, hippos and birds of prey. During the migration period (July to September), millions of animals cross from the Serengeti in Tanzania. On rainy days, millions of individuals of animals enter the reserve, the most prominent of which is the wildebeest herd, which sometimes moves in herds of up to two million items, which make their way with tens of thousands of items of common zebras and paratheses of various kinds. In the Mara Maasai you can find all the cat species that exist in Africa such as lions, tigers and cheetahs, which are considered the fastest animal in the world. We will return to the lodge at sunset.



Day 3 : Maasai Mara

After a fresh breakfast, we will board the safari vehicles and go deep into the reserve. In an amazing reserve land scape we will get to know the lifestyle of the many animals that are engaged in survival against the many predators or that make their way in search of food. This day will be dedicated to an in-depth safari in the Masai Mara Reserve, one of the most beautiful and fascinating reserves in East Africa. Masai Mara sits at the northernmost point of the Serengeti ecosystem, and is home to hundreds of bird species and dozens of species of birds of prey, rhinos, herds of giraffes and elephants that range from thorny bushes, hyenas, tigers, and glorious maned lions looking for their prey. The highlight of the day is the visit to the Mara River that runs along the reserve. Here we will observe the "big show" of the herds crossing the river. This is the culmination of the journey. Inside the river, hundreds of crocodiles and hippos are waiting for herds to cross the river and other predatory animals waiting across the bank for the tired herds. A nature spectacle where everyone wants to survive. Later, we will get to know the Maasai tribe. The tribesmen stand out in their traditional dress and in the special villages, where they lead their fascinating lifestyle in mud houses and cattle dung. During a visit to the village, we will get to know the fascinating lifestyle and semi-nomadic lifestyle of the tribesmen with their variety of traditional costumes, and we will even get to hear the women singing songs of blessing and the men bouncing to a great height, an ability given to them as part of the adolescent ceremonies they undergo. In the evening We will return to the lodge at sunset.

Day4: Maasai Mara to Lake Nakuru

After an early breakfast leaving the Masai Mara reserve to Nakuru Reserve directly for check-in and lunch. A short rest and immediately for a first tour of the reserve. The view of the lake is breathtaking. The Rift Valley step above the lake shore and dotted with euphoria and fever trees around the lake gives a spectacular picture of the lake and its surroundings. Nakuru means "dust or place of dust" in the Maasai language. And it is close to the town of Nakuru. Established in 1961. It started small, encompassing only the famous lake and the surrounding mountainous surroundings, but has since been expanded to include a large part of the savannahs. Observed hundreds of types of birds living around the lake, observed in the famous flocks of flamingos, Lake Nakuru offers easy viewing of the wildlife of most large safari animals. Among the predators we will meet: lions, cheetahs and tigers, those that are seen much more often in recent times. There are also large-sized pythons in the dense woods that can often be seen crossing roads or dangling through trees. We will continue our drive back to the lodge for dinner and accommodation. Lake Nakuru National Park

An encounter with the greatest bird spectacle on earth."

A little about Lake Nakuru Park: Renowned ornithologist Roger Torrey Patterson described the lake as "an encounter with the greatest bird sight on earth." Nakuru Lake is Kenya's most popular national park and is a great destination for a safari trip. Black hills enclose a small lake along whose shores stretches a thick stripe painted pink. This is Lake Nakuru in Kenya, home to flamingos and thousands of cormorants, antelopes and impalas. What's the secret of magic? Soda! The lake itself is incredibly small, and at first glance it is surprising that it manages to sustain around it and within it such a diverse abundance of birds and animals, the answer to this is somewhat surprising - since Lake Nakuru is not an ordinary lake, it is a lake of soda. The lake sits in the heart of an area with extensive volcanic activity. Mount Kilimanjaro and Mount Kenya to the east of the rift, and Mount Elgon to its west. Lake Nakuru National Park is the only fenced park in Kenya and is home to conservation projects for many diverse mammals. A visit to the reserve will give you a stormy experience, meeting you with all the power and splendor of nature. At sunset drive back to the lodge for dinner and accommodation.

Option:



NAIROBI "The heartbeat of Africa"



Nairobi located in southern Kenaya is the capital city with a population of about 3 million people . Being of the Africa fastest growing cities both politically and economically, it still offers a unique fusion of modern vibrate city and tradition. Its name comes from a Maasai word Enkare Nairobi, which means "cool water".

The city has great nightlife which indulging and lively , high-end cafes & restaurants offering beautiful and frighteningly delicious cuisines , and a broad range of accommodation that caters for all budgets , exactly the place to get some respite from the harshness of the continent.

Nairobi is the only city in the world with a national park within the city ,Nairobi National Park. At just 117 km², it is one of the country's smallest parks, but there is still an abundance of wildlife: Rhinos, Lions, leopard , cheetah, gazelles, warthogs, zebras, giraffes, ostriches , buffaloes and is also home to over 400 species of birds. It is a major tourist destination, along with other tourist attractions.

Other major attractions in the city include :

- Nairobi National Park
- Karen Blixen Museum,
- Giraffe Centre.
- Nairobi National Museum is the country's national museum and the largest in the city.
- Nairobi Gallery,
- Nairobi Railway Museum,
- Karen Blixen Museum.
- Uhuru Gardens, a national monument and Kenya's largest memorial park, are also where the first Kenyan flag was raised in independence. They are located along Langata Street near Wilson Airport.

Nairobi has something to offer for every age and pocket. Other notable sites include Jomo Kenyatta Mausoleum, National Theatre of Kenya, and National Archives of Kenya.

You can safely wander around the small city center and get to other places by taxi.

Suggested Nairobi City Tour Day Itinerary

A day city tour in Nairobi offers a perfect opportunity to see the city in no time, learn about Kenyan history, traditions and culture. During a tour of Nairobi, we will visit a variety of places. These are: Nairobi Centre, Snake Park, National Museum of Kenya, Kenyan Parliament Building, local bazaars and markets.

Nairobi National Park, Kenya

Nairobi National Park is the only park found within a city. The park is just 117 km², making it the country's smallest parks, but there is still an abundance of wildlife. Also referred to as Kifaru Ark for its successful role in rhino conservation (Kifaru means Rhino in Swahili), there are approximately 50 rhinos in the park, the densest concentration of black rhinos in Africa, a testament to their antipoaching measures.

Alongside rhinos, the park contains many animals: Lions, leopard , cheetah, gazelles, warthogs, zebras, giraffes, ostriches, buffaloes and is also home to over 400 species of birds. The Nairobi Safari Walk is a major attraction in Nairobi National Park as it offers visitors a rare experience of walking alongside the animals.

A picnic site, three campsites and hiking trails can be enjoyed for hikers. Of course, after visiting the big parks you will realize that the experience in Nairobi National Park is different but interesting.

Giraffe Centre

• Open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

This is a giraffe breeding center for a subspecies of the giraffe found only in the grasslands of East Africa the Rothschild giraffes. Giraffes are taken from the wild when they are still very young, and returned when they are big and strong enough to survive. Today, about 300 Rothschild giraffes roam throughout Kenya about the Center's activities. It is a wonderful and exciting experience to get so close to this beautiful and impressive animal, to feed and pet them. Within the center you will find special explanations about giraffes and the different varieties, a souvenir shop with artistic and inexpensive items, and a nice café. The center is inviting and fun, worth a visit, and provides an exciting and educational experience mainly for children.

David Sheldrick Elephant and Rhino Orphanage

• Feeding the elephants from 11:00 to 12:00.

It is a home for the breeding and conservation of orphaned elephants. The elephants are gathered from around the safari when they are alone or injured, and returned there when they are large and strong enough to cope with the challenges of nature. To date, about 50 elephants have been raised and preserved, which probably would not have survived without the orphanage.

It is a wonderful sight to see the mighty elephants from a close look so enjoying themselves in the mud pools and eating from bottles. The guides play with them with balls and tires and pamper them with a mud pool. The visit is recommended for both adults and children and do not forget about the camera because there is a lot to photograph.

Bomas of Kenya Cultural Centre in Nairobi

Kenya Cultural Centre Nairobi

• Performance times: 14:30 – 16:00

The Bomas is a cultural centre in Nairobi and is located near the main gate of Nairobi National Park.It is so high profile that it is almost a must visit for all guests coming to Nairobi.

Bomas of Kenya offers insight into all tribal groups in Kenya and allows you to see the diversity of cultures that make up this fascinating country. The center presents various aspects of proprietary culture, including lifestyles, crafts, music and dance.

The talented artists who are also residents of the cultural center perform traditional dances and songs taken from the various tribal groups in the country, including Arab-influenced Swahili taarab music, warrior dances, ambo drumming and Kikuyu circumcision ceremonies. Although the center is touristic, it is still a wonderful place to spend a spectacular afternoon outside the busy city limits. The complex consists of several bomas (villages), each built in the architectural style of Kenya's major ethnic groups.

The word Bomas comes from the Swahili word "Boma" which means farmhouse hence the plural word bomas. It was established by the government in 1971 as a subsidiary of Kenya Tourism Development Corporation as a tourist attraction. It also wanted to preserve, preserve and promote the rich and diverse cultural values of different tribal groups in Kenya.

Snake Park

• Open 8:00 – 17:30

A park that offers you a rare glimpse into the world of snakes, by means of snake cages made of glass, so that you are protected but you can enjoy in-depth and enjoyable observation. The bravest among you will also be able to physically touch some of the snakes.

Souvenir Shopping in Nairobi
