


Day 6

We get on the special jeeps for the land cruiser safari and go on a safari in the Taita Hills reserve from the special reserves of Kenya. Arrival at THE SALT LICK SAFARI LODGE, one of the most famous lodges in the world. Preparation and another departure for an evening safari. Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight. Full board



- Day 7 Second Day Safari: This day will be fully dedicated to a safari between the two reserves, after breakfast we drive to the Tsavo Reserve which is the largest reserve in Kenya, as soon as we enter the reserve, we will experience a real safari with some of the animals of the Big Five of Africa. The kitchen staff will meet us at the reserve and serve us lunch, continue the tour of the reserve and return to THE SALT LICK SAFARI LODGE for dinner and accommodation. Full board
- Day 8 The third day safari a morning tour of the reserve, return to the lodge for breakfast, a tour and departure from the reserve, an optional visit to the Maasai tribe and departure to the coastal city of Mombasa. Arriving at the hotel for rest, preparations for Shabbat.
- Day 9 Funzi Island Cruise Thousands of Israelis have defined the cruise to Funzi Island as an "unforgettable experience "Departure to the southern part of Mombasa, crossing by ferry, a day cruise to Funzi Island and the Disappearing Island on the Tanzanian border. Ride on a dhow and an authentic visit into the Swahili tribes located on the shores of the Indian Ocean. Lunch at the island's restaurant facing the sea and among the mangrove trees. Return to the hotel in the evening. Dinner, Performances and dances, it is recommended to go out for entertainment in the city of Mombasa.

Erev Shabbat and Shabbat Kodesh: With the help of God, we will do the holy Shabbat in a luxurious hotel with a special Shabbat atmosphere. The island of Mombasa connects all the reserves in all ways: whether departures by jeep, regular flights and private planes that land directly into the reserves. The island has hundreds of hotels and entertainment venues, restaurants, clubs, bars and pubs, casinos and golf courses, members' clubs, parks, marinas, adventure sports, water parks, entertainment venues for families, children's activities, diving, fishing, these are just a small part of what Mombasa offers you.

DETAILED ITINERARY FOR THE SAFARI EXPERIENCE AND EXCURSIONS IN KENYA (The order of the days may change)

Day 1: Thursday 10.04.2025 – Flying to Kenya – meeting in Mombasa. Hello and welcome to Kenya!

Welcome to the Land of Safari! Welcome to a week of vacation and excursions you will never forget! Our representatives will meet you at the airport and help you go through the route of the visa reception, baggage collection, meeting with the driver and accompanying you until you arrive at the hotel. At the hotel you will be greeted warmly and receive the suites. After getting organized and resting, you will meet us at the company desk located in the hotel lobby, you will receive an explanation of the week and tips for how to proceed, and then your vacation and travel week in Kenya will begin. On the first evening, you can go out and taste the rich nightlife that the island offers. Lunch and dinner

Day 2: Friday 11.04.2025 – Tour of the city of Mombasa, visiting villages and tribes. After breakfast, we will leave the beach hotel at 08:00 in the morning. A short drive to the city of Mombasa, the guide will accompany you throughout the tour and give explanations about Mombasa in the past and Mombasa today. A very "lively" and active day awaits you throughout the city of Mombasa, in the historical and new parts of the city.

First visit: "AKAMBA VILLAGE" We will drive to the western side of Mombasa and visit the artisan village called "Akamba Village" after the "Akamba" tribe (which is one of the 42tribes living in Kenya). The tribe is known for its talent for the art of carving and creating "tam tam" toffee. In the village we will discover the talents of African art in carving, sculpture, painting, of dozens and sometimes hundreds of artists working under makeshift wooden sheds. Here there will be an unmediated meeting with the artists and you will be able to Chat, take pictures and even join them and try your hand at carving a 10-pound elephant from mahogany with the traditional chisel. After a tour between the Ha and Minim sects, we will visit the main gallery in the village and you will be able to purchase some of the artists' works.

Second visit: - A tour of the city from the Artists' Village We will continue back to the city and drive on the "Mijikenda" road that takes us to the old train station (which is no longer in use) but was the main focal point when it came to the transportation system at the beginning of the 18th century. From there we will drive to the old "Kalindi" road which today is called "Moi Avenue" after the second president of Kenya. We will stop by the most famous momentum of the city of Mombasa "The giant "elephant teeth" built in the middle of the boulevard. These were created in 1952 to welcome Her Majesty - Princess Elizabeth on her first visit to Kenya. Right next door, we will walk around the "Uhuru Kenyata" garden, which was the first and mythical president of Kenya and even declared the independence of Kenya. We will walk among the huge mango trees with countless fruit bats hanging in clusters on the branches of the trees.

Third visit: "MARKITI" - We will continue to the "Digo" road and visit the Mombasa market, which is called "Markiti" by the locals, which was a stay in the colonial period, the municipal meeting hall for bricks only, has now become a beautiful fruit and vegetable market after the independence of Kenya. Around the market building, all the streets were turned into shops full of goodies, spices, dishes, fabrics, clothes and more... We will walk around and enjoy seeing the agricultural products that grow along the coastal area as well as those coming from the highland's region of Kenya. Lots of tropical fruits such as: mangoes, bananas, papaya, along with other crops: tomatoes, potatoes, cashews, coffee and tea.

Fourth visit: The Old City We will return to the bus and continue to the old city of Mombasa on the "Nkrumah Road" (this street is also home to the company's main offices and from here all the activity is also organized in Israel, Kenya, Egypt and Rwanda). Here you will get explanation about the city's rich culture and history. A tour of the narrow streets of the Old City, between the old Arab houses and the beautiful wooden balconies. On the street "Ndhia kuu" you will see the beautiful architecture seen on the doors, windows and balconies of these houses and then you will understand why the place is managed by UNESCO. We will visit the old fort called "Fort Jesus", which dominated the entrance to the ports of Mombasa, and thus effectively controlled the city. Today it is a museum confirming an arms base and displaying architectural works from the 15th century. It was built by the Portuguese to protect their business empire along the east coast of Africa, the use of the name "Jesus" and talk of Portuguese-presenting themselves as missionaries served only as a camouflage to prevent strong business competition.



Fifth visit: "Into the Villages" - a tour into the villages and the experience of life in After a light lunch, drive north (about eight kilometers) along the Mombasa-Malindi highway. We will pass through huge and endless orchards of "sisal" plants (from which ropes and aloe vera preparations are made) towards the villages of the Girima tribe. The Giriama tribe is the largest of the nine groups of tribes that make up the "Mijikenda" community - these are the tribal communities that sit on the coastal strips of Kenya. We will visit a local orphanage school to interact with the school administration and the children who will be happy to visit you. How much love you will receive from these children who are mostly helped by the locals who volunteer in the maintenance of the school. It is also an opportunity where you can give gifts to the children (such as pencils, candy, clothes, books, etc.)). From school we will drive to the village of Giriama called Gongoni village, walk inside the village, meet and stay with the local residents and learn the ethnicity of the Girima community. The adventure of the tour between the village paths and the bush paths will allow you to experience and enjoy the amazing ways of village life in Giriama:

- We meet people who are engaged in daily activities within their households and fields.
- We will visit inside the traditional gerayama houses that are built of mud and wood mulch.
- We will learn and experience a part of African culture.
- Drink the wine from the palm trees and freshly harvested coconut juice.
- We will learn about the different types of trees and fruits that grow in the coastal areas and taste them.
- And most of all, I enjoy the feeling of "genesis" and the beautiful views.
- We will leave the village and return to the hotel to prepare for Shabbat Kodesh.
 Erev Shabbat Kodesh: Kabbalat Shabbat and evening prayers in the hotel synagogue.

We will gather for a Shabbat meal in all its glory with the best delicacies and food. Shabbat songs and innovations.

Day 3 Saturday 12.04.2025: Sabbath & Eve of Pesach

"Shabbat HaGadol": waking up early for a pastoral Shabbat morning, for coffee and cake before prayer, morning prayers with Torah reading in the synagogue at the hotel, kiddush and cakes and a second meal. "Bi'ur Chametz". During the afternoon an amazing walk on the beach. The staff will take you on a walk during the low tide (sea safari) and watching the low tide that reveals the treasures of the sea and for walks in the areas close to the hotel or another activity of your choice.

Mincha and Seuda Shlishit: A varied meal. Conversations and Torah innovations.

The Eve of Passover. Holiday prayer. The Seder night "We are all weaving"

Day 4: Sunday 13.04.2025: Passover

Passover: Holiday prayer. Holiday meals, activities at the hotel and in the immediate vicinity of the hotel. Torah lessons, family and children's activities.

"Following the migration of animals in the corridor of the reserves"

Tsavo East National Park and Taita Hills Sanctuary



After an early breakfast (6:00 am) we leave the hotel and get on the safari vehicles. We will cross the city of Mombasa, which is already bustling with life at this time, and drive on the Mombasa Nairobi Road. We leave the city and here you really start to see the views of Kenya. The road passes between the picturesque villages populated by the Girama tribe. A glimpse into the economic aspect of the local community. These are mainly small-scale farmers who grow coconuts. Cashews, cassava and lots of corn.

We drive to the "Taita hills game sanctuary". This is actually the highlight of the trip. The reserve is the corridor where the animals from the two reserves (Tsavo East and Tsavo West)pass, so in a relatively small place we will see a large concentration of animals. The "Taita hills game sanctuary" is designated as a national park in Kenya. The park is in the Taita-Taveta district, about 220 km from Mombasa and covers an area of 28,000 acres. The park is adjacent to Tsavo West National Park and LUMO Community Wildlife Sanctuary. The definition of an "animal sanctuary" was given to the park because it is partially fenced off in order to separate the wild animals from the local residents. In the past, the animals would come to the villages and destroy the agricultural areas and the locals would be devoured by the predatory animals. In response, the locals would organize revenge campaigns and kill the animals.

TThe scenery is dramatic and all the wildlife in the plains is here. The park is home to elephants, lions, antelopes of various kinds, buffaloes, giraffes and more....

Still, most of the reserve is not fenced, so the number of wildlife varies throughout the year depending on natural environmental factors. The reserve has over 300 species of birds, some of which live in the reserve and some of which the reserve is a migration station where you gather forces for a journey between the continents. This huge diversity makes a tour of the reserve a game drive." for a unique and unforgettable experience and will provide you with opportunities for an amazing photo session, with a refreshing swimming pool amidst an amazing reserve landscape that provides peaceful and pastoral relaxation between tours of the reserve. The sanctuary is a success story in preserving nature and thriving wildlife. The tour routes are well monitored to ensure that animals are not disturbed, and some areas are completely closed to vehicles. This commitment to responsible ecotourism that is so supported by visitors ensures that the park's conservation and wildlife continue to thrive.









Back to the wild

Day7 Wednesday 16.04.2025 : (Safari Day 2) Tsavo East National Park

After breakfast depart from Taita lodge for Tsavo National Park, which is approximately 2 hours' drive you will enter the Tsavo East National Park through the Mtito gate. Tsavo East is separated from the western part by the railway line connecting Mombasa to Nairobi. There is no fence and no separation between the two parks and this allows animals to move freely from one side to the other.

The sight of dust-red elephant wallowing, rolling and spraying each other with the midnight blue waters of palm-shaded Galana River is one of the most evocative images in Africa. This, along with the 300-kilometer long Yatta Plateau, the longest lava flow in the world, makes for an adventure unlike any other in the Tsavo East. The park forms the largest protected area in Kenya and is home to most of the larger mammals, vast herds of dust -red elephant, Rhino, buffalo, lion, pods of hippo, crocodile, waterbucks, lesser Kudu, gerenuk and the prolific bird life features 500 recorded species.

In the afternoon we'll have our lunches and commence on a game viewing drive and enjoy seeing lots of wild life in their natural habitat. Here all the beauty of the reserve is revealed with the variety of wild animals. For those who love bird watching - this is the place to be! The ride along the Galena River offers just the perfect opportunity! Depart Tsavo park at sunset head back to Taita Hills Sanctuary.

Day8: Thursday 17.04.2025: (3rd day of the safari): Back to Mombasa

The day starts early, even before breakfast. We get into the safari vehicles and enter the depth of the reserve to try and catch some of the shy nocturnal creatures on the way back to their dens.

It's also an opportunity to spot the big cats that are undergoing hunting lessons with their young ones.

We will observe two encounters, between a reserve that goes to sleep and a reserve that wakes up to another stormy day of wild scenery and the search for food of predators and prey. Return to the camp for breakfast, get ready to depart the sanctuary heading back to the coastal city of Mombasa to our beach hotel. (Arrival in the evening)





Thousands of Israelis defined the Funzi Island cruise as "an unforgettable experience"

After an early breakfast we will meet at the hotel reception at 07:00 and drive through the city of Mombasa towards the southern end of the city - to the ferry. Here during rush hour you will meet thousands of lovely locals leaving the ferries for work in the city. When you get on the ferry you will see thousands of passengers lining up in perfect order on the sides of the ferry to cross with you to the other side. The ferry takes a few minutes to cross to the other side and you arrive at the village of Likoni. Drive south through the villages inhabited by the Digo tribe and throughout the drive from the sides of the road you will notice their economic lifestyle. The members of the Digo tribe are small-scale farmers who grow an abundance of cashews, coconuts, mangoes, cassava, sugar cane, rice, and even specialize in fishing.

We will pass the famous Diani Beach, which is ranked among the ten best beaches in the world. Drive through spectacular landscapes for approximately half an hour until almost to the Tanzanian border. Turn left and reach the village of Bodo. Bodo is a village on the shores of FUNZI Bay where your vehicles will park and board a Dhow (which is a traditional Arabian sailing boat) for a full day of amazing experience. This will be the first morning break since you left the hotel.

It's a quick African break of chai (tea) or kahwa {coffee}. Armed with a camera, you start sailing between the mangrove islands, watch and see the kingfish or the cormorant suddenly diving from the mangrove trees to catch a fish for breakfast, lunch. After a short cruise, Funzi Island appears in the distance. It is a relatively large village with a population of about 1,200people, who are the direct descendants of Persian Arabs and today from the Shirazi tribe. Here we will pass through the village and visit the elementary school, the village's water well, the local market and of course the local souvenir shop. The locals will be happy to welcome you and will even agree to host you in their homes.

You will be able to experience how they cook, eat and sleep. After visiting the village, we will return to the dhow we will enjoy the sea view and a cold drink. During the cruise sometimes you will notice the pods of dolphins who are just looking to play and chase the dhow boats and thus also get the attention of the passengers. The sand appears only at low time and here you can swim or snorkel or just go out to wander the island and relax in the hot pools like a natural hot tub. At noon, we will sail to the island of Kinazini where a sumptuous barbecue lunch awaits you. After lunch, you can relax on the famous Lamu beds scattered in the restaurant or go for another swim and from there drive back to the hotel. Approximate return to the hotel at 16:00.









Day10 Saturday 19.04.2025: Passover

A pastoral morning of Shabbat, for coffee and cake before prayer,
Morning prayers with Torah reading in the synagogue in the hotel, kiddush and cakes
and a second meal. During the afternoon there is activity at the hotel and going on
tours of the areas close to the hotel or any other activity of your choice.

Mincha and Seuda Shlishit: A varied meal. Conversations and Torah innovations. The end of the holiday and the Mimouna celebration.


MAMBA VILLAGE CENTRE (ABOUT 15 MINUTES' DRIVE FROM THE HOTEL)


