




Day 7 Cruise to Funzi Island - Thousands of Israelis defined the cruise to Funzi Mombasa Island as an "unforgettable experience": a trip to the southern part of Mombasa, half by ferry, a day of sailing to Funzi Island and the hidden island on the Tanzanian border. A dhow cruise and an authentic visit into the Swahili tribes on the shores of the Indian Ocean. Lunch at the island restaurant facing the sea and among the mangroves. Back in the evening to the hotel. Dinner, bar entertainment, performances and dancing, it is recommended to go out to Mombasa. Overnight at the hotel on Full board.

After breakfast, go on marine activities" Marine Park", "Sea Safari". Mombasa Day 8 Activities include snorkeling, glass boats, walking in the water at low tide and meeting the water animals.

Option B: Enjoy a day of health, massages, braiding, have a light lunch and transfer to the airport.








Mombasa Oh Mombasa

Mombasa non-stop 24/7

Mombasa is a major axis for the entire continent it's a port city through which most goods enter/leave and provide life to African countries. Mombasa Island connects all the reserves in all ways. The island has hundreds of hotels and entertainment venues, restaurants, clubs, bars and pubs, casinos and golf courses, members' clubs, parks, marinas, extreme sports, water parks, places of entertainment for families, children's activities. diving, fishing, this is only a small part of what Mombasa offers you.





Day 2: City tour in Mombasa and Bush Tour (Into the villages)

After breakfast, we will leave the hotel, drive to Mombasa city. A guide will accompany you throughout the tour and give explanations about Mombasa culture and history. A very "vibrant" and active day awaits you around the city of Mombasa.

- 1. "Akamba Village" named after the "Akamba" tribe (one of the 42 tribes in Kenya) known for its talent for Art carving, sculpture, painting, of dozens and sometimes hundreds of artists working under makeshift wooden sheds.
- 2. A tour of the city, starting with old train station (no longer in use) but was the main focal point concerning the transportation system in the early 18th century. Then drive along the old "Klindini" road today called "Moi Avenue" after the second president of Kenya, stop at the most famous momentum, the giant tusks served as a commemoration of the historical visit to Kenya by Queen Elizabeth II in 1952, next to "Uhuru Kenyata" garden which was the first and mythological president of Kenya and even declared the independence
- 3. Mombasa Market "MARKITI", the municipal meeting hall for whites only during the colonial period is now a beautiful tropical fruit, vegetable market after Kenya's independence. All around the market, Spices, utensils, fabrics, clothes, etc.
- 4. The Old City where the old fort called "THE FORT" which dominated the entrance to the ports of Mombasa and thus effectively controlled the city. Today it is a museum confirming a weapons base and displaying architectural works from the 15th century.

Into the villages - Drive north along the Mombasa-Malindi highway. We will pass through huge and endless orchards of the "sisal" plants (It yields a stiff fibre used in making rope and various other product) into the villages of the Giriama tribe (the largest of the nine ethnic groups of the Mijikenda people – Kenya coastal tribal communities)


Visit a local orphanage school interact with the school administration and the children. Then proceed with a local Giriama village visit, interact with the locals and learn the ethnicity of the Giriama community by

allowing you to:

- Meet people who engage in daily activities within their households and fields.
- Visit inside the traditional Giriama houses built of mud and wooden trunks.
- Learn and experience part of African culture.
- Treat yourself a fresh drink extracted from the palm trees and coconut
- · Learn different types of trees and fruits that grow in coastal areas.

Enjoy the view of beautiful landscapes.





Following the migration of animals in the reserves corridor Tsavo West Reserve and Taita Hills - Game Sanctuary

After an early breakfast (6.00am) depart from the hotel, pass through the city of Mombasa which is already bustling with life and connect the Mombasa –Nairobi Road which passes between the picturesque and populated villages. A glimpse into the economic aspect of the local community, who are mostly small–scale farmers who grow coconuts, cashews, cassava and lots of corn. Around 10.00 in the morning you enter the reserve, enroute game drive to the Lodge for check in, have lunch and relax for the afternoon.

In the evening, you will commence on a game viewing drive and enjoy seeing lots of wildlife in their natural habitat, the beauty of the reserve is revealed with the variety of wild animals. Return to the lodge at sunset for dinner.

Overnight at Reserve Camp/Lodge on a full board.

Tsavo East National Park

The Tsavo National Park is the largest park in Kenya (2081 km) and one of the largest in Africa! Tsavo East is separated from the western part by the railway line connecting Mombasa to Nairobi. There is no fence and no separation between the two parks and this and allows animals to move freely from one side to the other.

The sight of dust-red elephant wallowing, rolling and spraying each other with the midnight blue waters of palm-shaded Galana River is one of the most evocative images in Africa. This, along with the 300-kilometre long Yatta Plateau, the longest lava flow in the world, make for an adventure unlike any other in the Tsavo East. The park forms the largest protected area in Kenya and is home to most of the larger mammals, vast herds of dust –red elephant, Rhino, buffalo, lion, leopard, pods of hippo, crocodile, waterbucks, lesser Kudu, gerenuk and the prolific bird life features 500 recorded species.







Day 4: (Safari Day 2)- Tsavo East National Park - Taita Hills Sanctuary

After breakfast, depart Tsavo National Park head to Taita Hills Sanctuary. Arrive at Saltlick Lodge time for lunch, check in and relax for the afternoon.


In the evening enjoy a game drive in the Sanctuary which is home to several species of birds and animals including lions, elephants, giraffes and zebras. Return to the lodge at sunset for dinner.

Overnight at the Saltlick Lodge on a full board.

Taita Hills Sanctuary

A privately owned wildlife sanctuary and national park in Kenya established in 1972 by Hilton international. It is in Taita-Taveta County approximately 220 kilometres from Mombasa and 360 km south of Nairobi. The sanctuary covers an area of 28,000 acres (110 km2) and is adjacent to Tsavo West National Park and the LUMO Community Wildlife Sanctuary. It hosts cape buffalo, African bush elephant, leopard, lion, cheetah, Masai giraffe, zebra, hartebeest, impala, waterbuck, Thomson's gazelle, lesser kudu, dik-dik, Hyena, and other smaller animals, including a diversity of birdlife

The definition "animal shelter" was given to the park because it is partly fenced in order to separate the wild animals from the locals. In the past, the animals would come to the villages and destroy the agricultural areas and locals would be preyed upon by predators.



Day 5: (Safari Day 3): Taita Hills Sanctuary to Mombasa

An early morning game drive enabling you to observe two encounters, wildlife that goes to sleep and ones that wakes up to another day of wild scenery and food searches all wildlife.

Returning to the lodge for breakfast, check out and embark on your journey back to Mombasa. (Arriving at your beach Hotel in the afternoon / evening)

Dinner and overnight at Beach Hotel.

Friday eve: Kabbalat Shabbat with shabbat melodies and an Arabic prayer facing the sea. We will gather for a Shabbat meal in Rob with the best delicacies and food. Shabbat songs and innovations.

Day 6: Shabbat day

Holy Saturday:

Wake up for a pastoral Shabbat morning, coffee and cake before prayers, morning prayers with Torah reading in the hotel synagogue, kiddush and cakes and a second meal.

Afternoon: Sea Safari amazing walk on the beach (the staff will take you for a walk at low tide to watch the treasures the sea reveals) or alternative excursions in areas close to the hotel with activities of your choice.

The Lost Island - Tens of thousands of Israelis have described the cruise to Funzi Island as "an unforgettable experience."

Pick Up from your hotel, drive through the city of Mombasa and cross the local ferry to the south coast. In south coast, villages are inhabited by the Digo tribe, who are small-scale farmers that grow an abundance of cashews, coconuts, mangoes, cassava, sugarcane, rice, as well as specialize in fishing. Pass by the famous Diani beach (ranked among the ten best beaches in the world) drives through spectacular landscapes, to a village known as Bodo on the shores of Funzi Bay.

Upon arrival you will be served some African snack of chai (tea) or kahwa {coffee} served with Mahamari, then board a Dhow (which is a traditional Arabic sailing ship) and start sail between the mangrove to Funzi Island.

Funzi Island has a population of about 1200 people known as the Shirazi tribe. You will pass through the village; visit the elementary school, the village water well, local market and of course the local souvenir shop. Then return to the Dhow, enjoy the sea view with some cold drink and fruits heading to the sandbar (which only appears during low tide) for a swim, snorkelling or a stroll and relax in the hot pools (natural hot tub). At noon, we will sail to Kinazini Island where a sumptuous barbecue lunch awaits you.

After lunch, relax on the famous Lamu beds scattered throughout the restaurant or go for another swim and from there drive back to your hotel

Day 8: "Marine Park -", Departure from Kenya to Israel

After breakfast change into your swimming costumes depart for marine, enjoy the warm azure ocean, swaying coconut palms on white sandy beaches are to be found in the Mombasa Marine National Park and Reserve. The park blue waters are ideal for wind surfing, water skiing, snorkelling, and diving. They also provide a home to a colourful variety of marine species.

Return to the hotel to freshen up have a light lunch then depart to the airport for your departure flight back to Israel.
